

Notice of Property Tax Increase

The City of Stone Mountain has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 6.86 percent. All concerned citizens are invited to public hearings on this tax increase to be held at City Hall, 875 Main Street, Stone Mountain, GA 30083 on Monday, June 26, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at City Hall, 875 Main Street, Stone Mountain, GA 30083 on Wednesday, July 5, 2017 at 6:30 p.m.

The tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 22.270 mills, an increase of 1.429 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 20.841 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$57.16 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$125,000 is approximately \$71.45.
