

Notice of Property Tax Increase

The City of Stone Mountain has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 14.62 percent. All concerned citizens are invited to public hearings on this tax increase to be held at City Hall, 875 Main Street, Stone Mountain, GA 30083 on:

Wednesday, June 26, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.

Wednesday, June 26, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

Tuesday, July 2, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.

The tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 22.000 mils, an increase of 2.806 mils. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 19.194 mils. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$112.24 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$125,000 is approximately \$140.30.
