

ORDINANCE 2016-17

AN ORDINANCE BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY FOR THE CITY OF STONE MOUNTAIN, GEORGIA TO AMEND SECTION 28-601(d)(1) OF CHAPTER 28 STORMWATER UTILITY, ARTICLE VI. FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT AND FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE, TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

PART I

The Council of the City of Stone Mountain hereby ordains that Section 28-601(d)(1) of Chapter 28, STORMWATER UTILITY, ARTICLE VI. FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT AND FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION of *The Code of the City of Stone Mountain, Georgia* be amended as follows:

1. Delete Section 28-601(d)(1)

“The flood insurance study (FIS), dated _____, with accompanying maps and other supporting data and any revision thereto. [For those land areas acquired by a municipality through annexation, the current effective FIS and data for unincorporated Dekalb County, dated _____, with accompanying maps and other supporting data and any revision thereto.]”

in its entirety, and

2. Add new Section 28-601(d)(1)

The flood insurance study (FIS), dated May 16, 2013, with accompanying maps and other supporting data and any revision thereto. [For those land areas acquired by a municipality through annexation, the current effective FIS and data for unincorporated DeKalb County, dated May 16, 2013, with accompanying maps and other supporting data and any revision thereto.]

PART II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART III

If any section, clause, sentence or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

PART IV

This ordinance shall become effective on October 4, 2016.
