

ORDINANCE 2018-06

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF STONE MOUNTAIN SECTION 6.11 TO SET THE RATE FOR AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXATION

PART I

The Council of the City of Stone Mountain hereby ordains that an ad valorem tax at a rate of \$22.00 per every \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for the year 2018 be levied on all taxable property in the City of Stone Mountain to provide funding for City governmental purposes; and

Ad valorem real property taxes shall be billed in two installments and shall be past due if not paid on or before September 30, 2018 for the first installment and November 15, 2018 for the second installment. A penalty of 5% of the amount due shall be assessed on payments received after the past due date; and


This ordinance shall be promulgated by posting a notice of its adoption at City Hall within three days of action by the Mayor and City Council.


PART II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


PART III

This ordinance was proposed by Council Member Chakira Johnson with a motion to adopt. Thereafter, the motion was seconded by Council Member Diana Hollis. 5 Council Members voted in favor of the motion and 0 Council Members voted against the motion.
